## 2021 NEW ZEALAND SOLO DRUMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

## The New Zealand Solo Drumming Championship title is to be decided over two events:

### Event One

#### March, Strathspey & Reel

Minimum 4 parted tune for each element. Each competitor to submit two MSR sets.

### Event Two

#### Hornpipe & Jig

Minimum 4 parts for each tune (2 x 2 parted tunes not permissible). Only one set required.

- The adjudicators will rank the first 4 placings in each event. The overall winner will be the competitor with the highest points over the two events allocated as follows: 5 points 1<sup>st</sup>; 3 points 2<sup>nd</sup>; 1 point 3<sup>rd</sup>. If there are two competitors with equal highest points, the highest placing in the March, Strathspey & Reel event will be awarded the RNZPBA Solo Drumming Champion Title.
- The adjudicators will be appointed by the RNZPBA. The adjudicators' decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Each competitor must be accompanied by 1 piper.

- All competitors AND their pipers shall follow the RNZPBA standard rules of dress as a minimum.
- If there are more than 14 entries, elimination heats will be run on Saturday afternoon with 6 selected from each heat for the evening event. If there are 14 or less entries, all will progress straight to the final.
- By submitting an entry, a competitor acknowledges their permission is granted for their performance to be live-streamed and promoted for future events.
- Competitors will be responsible for reporting to the steward on arrival. It is the competitor's responsibility to be ready to compete when their position in the order of play arrives.
- Entries close on **30 October 2021**. Names of tunes to be submitted by **10 November 2021**.
